

What is Purpose & Need?

- 1. Defines the transportation problem
- 2. Limits range of alternatives- "reasonable, prudent and practicable"
- 3. Guides the alternatives analysis process
- 4. Clear, well-justified, specific and comprehensive





Route 7/15 Norwalk - DRAFT PROJECT PURPOSE

- Improve system linkage between Route 7 and the Merritt Parkway
- Improve the mobility for all users at the Merritt Parkway's Main Avenue and Route 7 Interchanges
- Improve safety in the vicinity of these interchanges







Route 7/15 Norwalk - DRAFT PROJECT NEED

- System linkage: need to provide complete connections between Route 7/Merritt Parkway
- Safety: current interchanges have safety deficiencies
- Mobility: additional linkages need to improve user mobility
- Congestion: need to reduce congestion and delays at intersections





Route 7/15 Norwalk- DRAFT GOALS & OBJECTIVES

Provide other factors that will be considered in the alternatives evaluation process

- Ensure long-term serviceability of corridor
- Maximize public investment in corridor
- Ensure better interchange integration with environment and neighborhood context
- Provide for pedestrian and bicycle access
