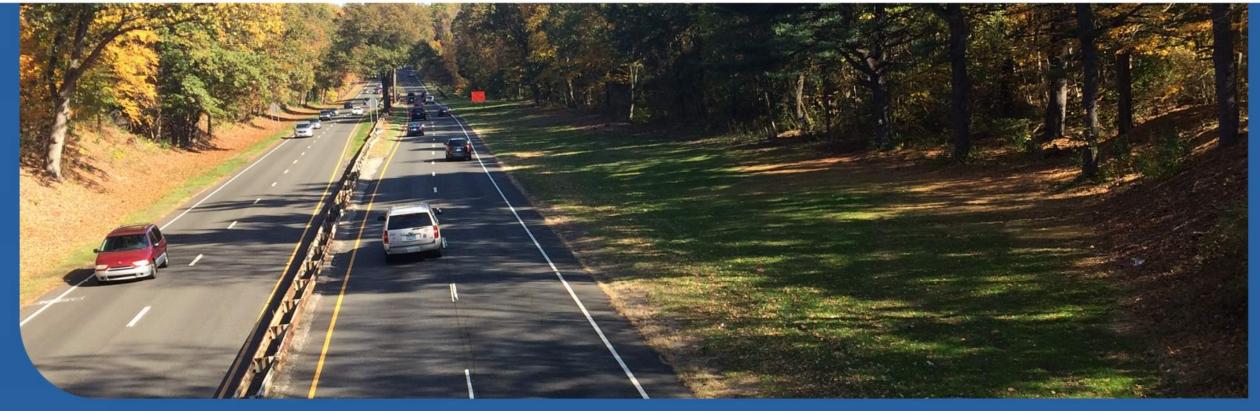



#### **Project Purpose and Need**

#### Roadway System Linkages

Construct missing connections between Route 7 and 15

#### Safety

 Address substandard acceleration/deceleration lanes, steep changes in grades, sharp curves, and limited sight distances

#### **Mobility**

- Provide local road network improvements to Main Avenue, Glover Avenue, and Creeping Hemlock Drive
- Provide improvements to bicycle, pedestrian, and transit facilities, including ADA compliance










**TYPICAL SECTION – ROUTE 7**



#### Final Design, Right of Way, and Permitting

- FHWA Design Approval: Summer 2025
- Final Design and Permit Complete: Summer 2027
  - Section 106 Memorandum of Agreement (MOA)
  - Merritt Parkway Landscape Coordination
  - Continued PAC and Public Involvement

#### Construction

- Begin Construction: Late 2027/Early 2028
- Anticipated Construction Duration: 3-4 Years

#### **Total Construction Cost = \$162.3M**

- 80% Federal Funding
- 20% State Funding
